Instructions

1. All students on academic probation and all students who wish to appeal the loss of eligibility to receive financial aid or an academic dismissal (suspension) must develop, with the help of an academic advisor or professional counselor, an Academic Plan that will enable them to achieve satisfactory academic progress within a specific period of time.
2. Verify your academic record. For this, you must print a credit transcript, available at www.inter.edu by selecting the following links: InterWeb /Student Services /Student Record /Transcript.
3. To determine the courses that you must take according to your program of study course sequence plan, print the Preliminary Academic Evaluation by selecting the following links: InterWeb / Student Services / Student Record / Preliminary Academic Evaluation.
4. In following section of this document, indicate the dates of the terms in which you will enroll, the courses you will take, and the grades you must obtain in order to achieve satisfactory academic progress. You must give priority to repeating the courses you have failed. If you receive your financial aid in **semesters**, you must complete **two terms**; if in **trimesters**, you must complete **three terms**; and if in **quarters (bimesters)**, you must complete **four terms**.
5. Discuss your Academic Plan with a professional counselor or an academic advisor. He will help you complete and validate the final agreement. He will help you decide which courses to take and the grades you must obtain in order to achieve the GPA and pace of completion you need to reach satisfactory academic progress.
