Admission Requirements

Associate Degree Program in Nursing

1. Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 from the previous institution of study.
2. Submit evidence of holding an approved degree from a recognized and accredited institution for the Associate Degree in Nursing (official transcript or credential evaluation).
3. Submit the following additional documents: government-issued photo ID, Social Security card, Birth Certificate, and immigration documentation according to status (Permanent Resident Card, U.S. Passport, approved Form I-797 with Employment Authorization Card, or Student Visa).
4. Submit evidence of having completed one year or more of studies in the United States, or provide evidence of passing the TOEFL English exam with a minimum score of 78 or higher.

Bachelor's Degree Program in Nursing

5. Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 from the previous institution of study.
6. Submit evidence of holding an approved Associate Degree in Nursing from a recognized and accredited institution.
7. Submit the following additional documents: government-issued photo ID, Social Security card, Birth Certificate, and immigration documentation according to status (Permanent Resident Card, U.S. Passport, approved Form I-797 with Employment Authorization Card, or Student Visa).

8. It is recommended to submit evidence of having passed the NCLEX (Board of Nursing).
9. Submit evidence of having completed one year or more of studies in the United States, or provide evidence of passing the TOEFL English exam with a minimum score of 78 or higher.

Clinical Practice Requirements

10. A current negative criminal background check issued by the Police Department of the county of residence.
11. A Health Certificate valid for one year, issued by a licensed physician.
12. Proof of immunizations: Hepatitis B (within last 10 years), Varicella vaccine or titers, COVID-19 vaccines (minimum two doses), and Influenza vaccine.
13. CPR certification issued by the American Heart Association.

Some agencies and courses may require additional requirements. The student is responsible for complying with any additional requirements required by the clinical practice agency.

Transfer and Relocation Requirements

14. Comply with all admission standards for transfer or relocation students as established in the General Catalog.
15. Admission requires prior authorization from both program directors.
16. Submit evidence of having completed one year or more of studies in the United States or provide evidence of passing the TOEFL English exam with a minimum score of 78 or higher.
